



## Temporary Exhibit Galleries to Re-open

The McLean County Museum of History is excited to be planning for the re-opening of its temporary exhibit galleries in 2023, 2024, and 2026. Following repairs to our roof and galleries our plans are as follows:

- **2023** – Opening in the fall of 2023, our Merwin Gallery will feature items from our collection that are not part of a permanent exhibit. Items will rotate in and out of this gallery on a regular basis.
- **2024** – Opening in the spring/fall of 2024, an asbestos exhibit will open exploring the story of what happened at Bloomington’s asbestos plant, in which hundreds died slow and painful deaths as a result of exposure to asbestos.
- **2026** – Opening in the spring of 2026, a baseball/softball exhibit will open exploring the vast history of America’s Favorite Pastime in McLean County.
