Brief History

This small collection along with a large collection of photographs was found in the attic of a house in Normal, IL. James C. Harvey was a local businessman (ca 1900-1930). He was affiliated with the Continental Packaging Co. and L. B. Thomas & Son prior to his partnership with Mr. Hackett in the Hackett-Harvey Company. The Hackett-Harvey Company was an early area automotive parts supplier. His son James C. Harvey, Jr. was also associated with the Hackett-Harvey Company and served as its secretary-treasurer. Another son Robert E. Harvey (b. 1922) was a pianist and graduated from the Illinois Wesleyan School of Music. Robert Harvey was also an amateur photographer.

This collection includes memorabilia from grade and high schools, Illinois State University, Illinois Wesleyan University, First Baptist Church, concert programs, newspaper articles, personal correspondence, etc.
