Brief History

Born in 1906, Charlotte Murray wed Bloomington-born Thomas Hayden in 1933, after he had lost his first wife. The couple farmed east of Bloomington for many years and raised twin sons Tom (Thomas) and Jerry (Jerome). The couple were members of Holy Trinity. He died in 1950; she in 2001.
