Brief History

Illinois Wesleyan University was founded in 1850, with its first building erected in its current campus only a few years later. Starting as a small private Christian university, it has since expanded into a large institution which was the alma mater of many distinguished individuals including Adlai Stevenson I, among others.

Scope Note

Although only in a single box, the collection informs on many aspects of Illinois Wesleyan University. General history is reserved for Folder 1, including the Executive bylaws and landmark news remarking on their most well-known buildings coming into fruition. Folder 2, however, focuses on induction and commencement programs for incoming students dating as far back as 1863. Folders 3 and 4 contain information—news and correspondence—of IWU presidents and their activities. The next folder, Folder 5, contains articles and news on dedications of buildings on campus to members of the community.

Folder 6 deals in more mechanical aspects of student and teacher living. This includes course catalogues for students, code books for faculty and students, among others. In Folder 7, there are several news bulletins—short brochures of information on important workings of notable faculty or student projects and similar items. Folder 8 exclusively contains objects meant as advertisement and promotion for IWU or IWU professors advertising for other companies. These include assurance pieces of the Christian nature of the institution and advertisements within newspapers like the *Pantagraph*.

Contained in Folder 9 is brochures and pamphlets for theater programs performed at IWU, most often those which students performed. Folders 10, 11, and 12 contain brochures, pamphlets, and other information and advertisements for college music programs. Similarly, Folder 13 contains advertisements and news of art exhibits at IWU.

Folder 14 contains mostly news and general information of IWU athletics, but also information on dedications of sport buildings. Alumni news and correspondence is contained in Folder 15, as well as brochures of alum visits and events. Folder 16 has objects difficult to define within any of the other folders, including those of extended college programs not part of the main campus and news of events that are not theater, art, music, or sports related.

Folder 17 contains brochures on the Greek fraternities and sororities including the Sigma Chi fraternity. Folder 18 has books of IWU songs for sporting events and ceremonies. Folder 19 includes information on IWU's school of Nursing including brochures and lists of nursing students. Folder 20 contains objects pertaining to 15th IWU president Robert S. Eckley, which include speeches, articles, and even a memorial article.

Folders 21 and 22 are annual reports which inform on concerns, cornerstones, and general static information for the year of their release. Folder 23 holds news and brochures on IWU's Ames Library. Folder 24 holds Homecoming brochures.
