Brief History

The Judd Family lived in Colfax, Illinois during the 20th century. The Judd and Lucas families were united when Earl J. Judd, son of Earl A. Judd and Edith Mcreary, married Elsie R. Lucas, daughter of Herman Lucas and Anna Richardson.

This collection was acquired along with the Bessie Hibarger Family collection additions. It is unclear how the Hibarger and Judd/Lucas families were connected.

Scope

This collection includes documents connecting the Judd and Lucas families including a brief genealogy. The majority of the collection is documents pertaining to the Judd Family. It includes many documents relating to the roles of the Judd family including association memberships, essays, and teaching certificates. The collection lacks biographical information such as birthdates and marriages.
