Brief History

The Patrinmar Bridge Club was a club for Catholic women, established in 1928 by the Rev. Stephen Moore, pastor of Holy Trinity Church, Bloomington. It was begun as a young Catholic women's organization. The name is derived from the name of three parishes in Bloomington: Holy Trinity, St. Patrick's, and St. Mary's. Membership and meeting times varied. The club disbanded in 2023.

The collection includes documents related to the Patrinmar Bridge Club's history, activities, and finances. Minutes and membership directories are also featured, along with miscellaneous items.
