## Brief History

Nancy Jane Peairs documented her years at Unit 5 in two scrapbooks. They mainly included Junior High and Senior High school. There was some Elementary school news and programs. She also noted many of the activities at University High School where she attended at least one summer school session.

Nancy's selection of newspaper articles, programs, invitations, and memorabilia documented her interests. There were numerous sports articles throughout both scrapbooks, as well as newspaper accounts of plays and concerts along with their programs. Club memberships and holiday dance favors reflected social involvement.

Nancy did not write personal notes or observations in either scrapbook. Her report cards, which always contained high marks, were signed by her father, Ralph P. Peairs, local physician.

## Scope

This collection covers Nancy Jane Peairs school experiences from late elementary through high school in the Unit 5 School District. There are two scrapbooks. Scrapbook 1 is divided into Home Room, Girl Reserves, Boy Scouts, Jr. High News, Our Good Times, Snaps, Signatures, P.T.A., School Board, Sports/Graduation, Cub,Boy,Eagle Scouts Activities, and Commencement.

Scrapbook 2 is not divided into sections. The first pages are numbered through 97 and bundled together according to arbitrary topics. The remaining 25 entries contain related articles.
