Blank reports are often not coordinated with the weekly reports and may just be copies. ## Historical Overview

The passage of the National Interstate and Defense Highways act of 1956 saw a dramatic influx of federal funding into public works, especially those concerning interstate travel. Communities across America felt the immediate effects of these immense projects. In 1967 with the near completion of Interstate 74 and Interstate 55, Bloomington, Illinois had concerns about increased traffic volume. These concerns were wrested within the perception that accidents would likely increase with the completion of aforementioned projects. This combined with repeated drowning occurrences at Lake Bloomington and various airport accidents, gave rise to a team of volunteers which sought to provide McLean County with a quick response squad. Working in tandem with local authorities and emergency services, the McLean County Emergency Squad would provide support in a plethora of ways, responding to each unique situation with prompt professionalism.

In May of 1967 at a County Board meeting, huge strides were made for the conception of this organization. Prior to this point, Sheriff Carl Slayback, Coroner Curtis Gilberts, plus Chenoa resident and WWII veteran O.B. Streeper had been providing a wide variety of basic rescue services; all of which were hosted from the trunk of Mr. Streeper's Thunderbird. The need for a greater variety of rescue equipment, a proper response vehicle, along with other necessary rescue accouterments became increasingly apparent. This pervasive necessity led to a presentation by Sheriff Slayback, J.A. Thomas the County Civil Defense director and four prospective members of the makeshift rescue squad: Keith Lemons, Danvers fire chief; Merle Parry of Chenoa, Charles E. Murray Civil Defense director of Normal and Coroner Curtis M. Gilberts. Requesting a sum of \$4,500 for equipment, the small committee of volunteers pitched their idea of a pro bono emergency team, quoting the success of a Sangamon County operation (an operation that O.B. Streeper was a member of) that was akin to their conceptualization. The presentation team was met with an offer by the County Board following their presentation. \$14,000 of County Funds would be allocated by the Board of Supervisors for use by the unpaid unit, fulfilling and exceeding the expectations of the early emergency squad.

January of 1968 saw the original ten volunteers of the squad deeply imbued with a sense of dedication, spending five of their seven days purchasing equipment and drilling emergency procedures. O.B. Streeper, charged with leading the organizations team in rescue situations and training, led a variety of exercises including: fire extinguishing (both with and without water), diving drills, victim removal and resuscitation, vehicle disassembly, etc. Streeper hoped that by July 1<sup>st</sup>, the squad would be ready to move out, furnished in their new rescue vehicle assembled and designed by Streeper and his team. Such a goal was achieved and the variety and intensity of training provided ample conditioning for real-life rescue scenarios. Within its first six years of service the Emergency Squad had made over 200 confirmed emergency runs, donating over 2,285 man hours to training and aforementioned runs. The Squad House created on 901 North Main in Normal, would act as a focal point for emergency professional development and become the headquarters for generations of individuals looking to serve their community.

However, it wouldn't be until June 12th of 1979 that an ordinance would be introduced by the McLean County Board of Supervisors which created an "official" emergency squad, one complete with official offices under the purview of the McLean County Board of Supervisors. While the emergency squad had been acting under the McLean County Board and receiving funding, the 1978-1979 Civil Service Reform Act (in response to Watergate) could have prompted a more pronounced codification of government civilian employees. Prior to this point

the McLean County Emergency Squad was performing under the, “McLean County Rescue Squad By-Laws” that were established in 1970; these new ordinances would effectively repeal these previously standing legal statutes. As such, the “McLean County Emergency Rescue Squad” was formed consisting of: one office to be known as Chief of the McLean County Emergency Rescue Squad (O.B. Streeper would reprise this role until 2005) and several offices, each to be known as member of the McLean County Emergency Rescue Squad. This ordinance also introduced a variety of rules and regulations which governed the operation of the Rescue Squad, placing certain requirements upon each squad member. Following requirements set by Roy J. Henderson, the chairman of the McLean County Board in 1979, in October of 1982 a similar change would occur with a new uniform system of codification across ordinances and resolutions. A relative minor change occurred, transferring the Emergency Rescue Squad’s formation ordinance into Chapter 7 of the McLean County Code, which was designated, “Emergency Services”.

From 1979 onward the McLean County Emergency Rescue squad would find itself performing new roles for a variety of accidents. Soon the squad became the only functioning unit to engage in Hazmat services, following a brief period of training, which assisted in its continual funding when convincing the county board to retain a section of the budget for their services. While the squad has certainly met some budgetary cuts when entering the 2000’s, it still remains functional. However, it has been diluted slightly from what it once was; being amalgamated into the McLean County Emergency Services and Disaster Agency/ Rescue Squad, due to budgetary cuts and the formation of Rescue Squads by surrounding areas.

## **Scope**

The collection includes newspaper articles referencing the formation of the Emergency Squad along with its deeds, thank you letters from corresponding emergency services, a short brochure explaining the squad’s duties, a packet marked “Emergency Squad McLean County” with its symbol containing an overview of the purpose of the organization and their equipment, two cards certifying Jym Robinson and Gary Gundy as cardiopulmonary resuscitation and emergency cardiac care providers, a CD-ROM marked “McLean Co. Emergency Squad”, Purpose statements and requests by O.B. Streeper and squad members to the McLean County Board, Emergency Rescue Squad Ordinances 7.71; 7.72; 7.76; 7.77 and the “Amending the Numerical and/or Alphabetical Designations of the Sections and Paragraphs of Certain McLean County Ordinances,” Ordinance of October 19<sup>th</sup> 1982, Line graph indicating McLean County Emergency Squad Calls averages from 1979-2001, McLean County Accounts Payable Detail Journal for the Emergency Squad from 1/01/87-12/31/87, McLean County Accounts Payable Detail Journal for the Emergency Squad from 1/01/88-6/17/88, depreciation listing for physical inventory, McLean County expenditure accrual accounts status for June, 1988, records of emergency run reports; truck and equipment checklists; and squad meetings from 1978-2005, photos of corresponding emergency runs from 1968-1998 (contains a variety of photos from unknown dates).
